

VLS Newsletter May 2018

The total number of cases has now reached 58, with 50 archived and 8 cases currently under investigation. Of the recent influx of cases the majority relate to 5w30 automotive engine oil which is a staple product of the after and service fill markets.

Recent trends for OEMs to require their own engine oil variant coupled with the aftermarket need to rationalise stockholding particularly in the workshop sector could be one factor that has led to an increase in the number of marketing claims made on automotive engine oil products.

VLS Case 010150

VLS were unable to procure the product on the open market and consequently the case could not be proven. For any case to be accepted, the product must be available for open sale on the UK market, so consequently the case was archived.

VLS Case 010151

This case relating to a Fully Synthetic 5W/30 lubricant is approaching the conclusion stage of the initial investigation and the Named Party's actions to bring the product into compliance are currently under review.
